

Welcome to Romain Rolland Library!

Our services

- You can borrow 10 books at a time for a period of 3 weeks: come to the library desk with your library card and the choosen books.
- You can extend the loan period for another 3 weeks (2 times maximum), as long as the documents are not reserved by another patron. Extensions can be made at the library desk, by phone, by e-mail or online with your user account.
- Reserving documents: you can ask at the library desk or by phone. We will call you when the book is ready for you.
- Checking your user account online (borrowed books list, due date, booked documents list...).
- Using our computers: give your library card to the desk (children under 12 years old have to be with a grownup). You can use Internet, programs and print documents (0,20€ / page).

Your registration is valid in the four libraries of Evere and Schaerbeek network!

How to register?

- You have to give an ID card or a passport and your Biblio-pass (library card) if you already own one from another library.
- Children under 15 years old have to come with a tutor or give the parental autorisation given by the librarians.

How to connect to your online user account?

- Ask at the libary desk to activate your user account. You will recieve a PIN code.
- Then, go on Biblio.brussels >> Mon compte and follow the instructions (only in french).

Evere Library has more than 50000 documents:

Adult and children books, Strips, picture books, newspapers and magazines, books in foreing languages, audio books, bigger font books, easy french books...

Coming to the library is free: reading inside, use the wifi, meeting other people...

How to find a document?

- To search a document, you can ask a libarian for help, refer to the classification plan or consult our online catalog.
- Our online catalogue will inform you at
 - knowing if the library has a specific document;
 - if it is available and if you may borrow it;
 - where it is in the library (a librarian will fetch it for you if it is in the Reserve);
- If we do not have the document you're looking for, the librarian can ask it to another library with our inter-libraries system. You can also suggest acquisition of the document by the library.

Ask for the schedule!

- The library often organises shows, author meetings, activities and more.
- You will find more information and the agenda on our desk, our website or on our social medias (Facebook and Instagram).
